Elderly TOWN Benefit

For new applicants only; you do not need to reapply every year.

New Applications must be received by May 18, 2020 (extended due to Town Hall being closed on the 15th). Applicants must be 65 and living in Redding as their Domicile Residence for 3 Years.

Elderly STATE Benefit

New Applications deadline is May 18, 2020 (extended due to the Town Hall being closed on the 15th). Applicants must be 65 and fall under the income guidelines of \$45,100 married / \$37,000 unmarried per 2019 taxes.
