

Park and Recreation Covid-19 Program Protocols

General protocols for all Park and Recreation programs

- No one is permitted to come to a class if they're showing signs of illness.
- Anyone demonstrating signs of illness will be sent home.
- The Redding Park and Rec reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone not wearing a mask or are showing signs of COVID-19
- Park and Rec reserves the right to have limited group sizes to meet distancing requirements

Tennis lessons

- Outside, groups of 8 per lesson w/ 1 instructor
- Masks worn until student steps on assigned court
- Instructor will wear mask at all times
- Hand sanitize before and after the lesson
- Instructor will pick up tennis balls
- Parents will remain in cars

Outside programs

- Outside on the field, canceled if inclement weather
- Masks worn until student gets to field
- Instructor will wear mask at all times
- All staff and participants will hand sanitize before and after the class
- Students will have minimal contact with equipment
- Students will be six feet apart, when possible, depending on activity
- Instructor to sanitize equipment after class
- Parents will remain in cars

Indoor programs

- All staff and participants will hand sanitize before and after the class
- Students will have minimal contact with equipment
- Students will be six feet apart, when possible, depending on activity
- Instructor to sanitize equipment after class
- Participants to wear mask at all times.
- Instructor will wear mask at all times.
- Hand sanitize before and after the class
- Parents will remain in cars (if youth program)

Reporting procedure

All notifications from staff with a positive Covid test OR have been in close contact with a person who is Covid positive will be reported immediately to their supervisor who will then report the information to the Town of Redding Health Department. All notifications from a program participant with a positive Covid test OR have been in close contact with a person who is Covid positive will be reported immediately to the Park and Recreation Department who will then report to the Town of Redding Health Department. No one testing positive will be permitted to return unless they have completed the required 10 day isolation period and been symptom free for 24 hours. Anyone who has been informed that they are a contact with a positive case must quarantine 14 days from the last time they were exposed to the positive case. Those who are considered contacts must inform the program supervisor. Redding P&R will follow the most recent protocols and guidelines provided to us from the Health Department when informing participants and staff.
