Note that for projects that need approval from the Water Pollution Control Commission or the Conservation Commission, a decision may not be made by the Zoning Commission until those approvals are obtained.

Approvals granted by the Zoning Commission are approvals for the *use* of the property only; any construction requires administrative approval from town land use departments as well as the building department.



The undersigned understands that this application is to be considered complete only when all information required by the Commission has been submitted and is responsible for payment of all required legal notices and mailings. Further, the undersigned warrants the truth of all statements contained herein and in all supporting documents according to the best of his or her knowledge and belief and hereby grants permission to the Redding Zoning Commission and their Authorized Agent to enter the subject property for the purposes of reviewing the application, inspection, and enforcement of the Zoning Regulations of the Town of Redding.

**PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY
CT DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH
NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**

Effective October 1, 2006, applications for any project located within a public water supply watershed area before the Zoning Commission, Zoning Board of Appeals, Planning Commission, or the Conservation Commission must notify the Commissioner of the Connecticut Department of Public Health (CTDPH).

In order to determine if your project is in this area, consult the “*Public Drinking Water Source Protection Area Map*” on file in the offices of the Redding Town Clerk, Land Use, and the Redding Zoning Enforcement Officer. If your project falls within this area, please follow the notification process detailed below:
