

Update on Masking Policy



As you may know, most classes and programs have resumed in-person, both indoors and outdoors.

Outdoor Classes

Participants in outdoor classes and programs are not required to wear masks. If it is difficult to keep distant or if the outdoor space is crowded, participants should wear a mask.

Indoor Programs and Classes

Participants who have been fully vaccinated are not required to wear masks if they can keep their distance in indoor programs and classes. Those who have not been fully vaccinated are still required to wear masks.

This policy is based on a vaccine honor system.

Love Coffee?


Monday, May 24, 10:30 am
