Redding Mask Order Lifted

The daily rate of COVID-19 cases has declined regionally and in Redding they have dropped below 10 per 100,000 for three weeks in a row. As a result, the mask mandate in town will be lifted effective Friday, October 15th. Our current daily case rate is 7.8 per 100,000.

State mandates continue to require masks in schools and for unvaccinated individuals in indoor public spaces. Face coverings are optional for fully vaccinated individuals.

Even though the mask mandate has been lifted we strongly recommend all Redding residents, and especially for those at higher risk of severe COVID-19, continue mask wearing when indoors in public areas, and when distancing cannot be maintained.

We ask for your cooperation when visiting Redding establishments and locations where some have chosen to maintain the full mask policy for the safety of their staff and customers.
