JANUARY 2022 LEGAL NOTICE

ELDERLY TAX BENEFITS

The application period for the Town of Redding Elderly Benefit and State of CT Homeowners Program is beginning February 1, 2022.

Redding residents aged 65 years or older may apply for both benefits provided they meet the qualifications listed below.

APPLICATIONS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE TOWN OF REDDING ASSESSOR'S OFFICE OR ONLINE AT TOWNOFREDDINGCT.ORG

APPLICATION PERIOD IS FEBRUARY 1, 2022 – MAY 16, 2022

1. State of CT Homeowners Program

- a. Must be 65 years of age by December 31, 2021
- b. Must be a homeowner with a principal residence of Redding as of October 1, 2021
- c. 2021 total income must not exceed \$38,100 for unmarried persons, and \$46,400 for married couples.

After April 15, 2022, application must be made in person.

2. Town of Redding Elderly Benefit

- a. Must be 65 years of age by May 16, 2022
- b. Must be a homeowner in the Town of Redding since May 16, 2019
- c. The property for which the benefit is claimed must be the legal domicile of such person, and occupied more than 183 days of each year.
- d. Copy of CT drivers license

The Town of Redding will be accepting applications for both benefits from February 1, 2022 – May 16, 2022. Applications are available both in person and online. Please reach out to the Assessor's Office with any questions at (203) 938-2626.
