The Office of the Registrar of Voters will be holding a voter registration session on Tuesday, February 15, 2022, from 12:00-2:00 p.m. for the purpose of registration and/or enrollment of electors entitled to vote in the primary. We will be holding this registration session in person at Town Hall in the Hearing Room.

When registering to vote for the first time you must have a valid photo ID that shows name and address. If your ID does not show your current address (i.e. you recently moved here from a different town or state) please also bring a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or government document that shows your name and address.

The purpose of this Election is to elect members to the Democratic Town Committee. The Democratic Town Committee has 40 seats therefore voters will be able to vote for 40 candidates. This Election is only open to registered Redding Democrats.

Dates to Remember

January 1st - was the last day to Transfer from one political party to another. Unaffiliated voters may change any time in respect to the deadlines set below. (Refer to mail in/online and in person deadlines)

February 15th from 12pm - 2pm **Voter Registration and Enrollment Session** at Town Hall, 100 Hill Rd, Redding CT 06896.

February 26th **Deadline for Mail in and Online Voter Registration** - Your completed mail in registration form must be postmarked or received by the Registrar by February 26th to be eligible to vote in the Primary.

February 28th at 12 pm **Deadline for In-Person** - Enrolling and Registering to vote in Primary.

March 1st, from 6am - 8pm - **Democratic Town Committee Primary** to be held at the Redding Community Center, 37 Lonetown Rd (Behind the Redding Elementary School) Redding, CT 06896.

Note: To be eligible to vote in this Primary you must be a Redding registered voter **and** enrolled in the political party holding the Primary.
